Assessment	Type	Population	Window	Purpose
CMAS + CoAlt	State	3rd - Math + ELA  Future years - 4th-6th Math + ELA and Grade 5 (Science)	April 7th-24th	The state of Colorado requires all schools to administer CMAS to all 3rd-5th grade students. CMAS scores are used at the state and local level to help determine student academic growth and achievement as well as the schools ability to deliver instruction. Scores are analyzed at a school level, district level, and state level.
WIDA Screener	State	Students who qualify for ELD programming	First 30 days of the school year - August 12th	Used to screen to access new students who are dual language learners within the first 30 days of school. This information is used to determine academic supports and who will be given the WIDA assessment later in the school year.
ACCESS for ELLs	State	Multilingual Learners (NEP + LEP)	January 9th - February 10th	State of Colorado uses WIDA/ACCESS as a standardized measurement of a student's ability to access and use the English language. This information is used to determine programming and academic growth.
TS Gold		PreK-K	First 30 days of the school year, September 3rd-September 13th, December 16th-18th, March 3rd-7th, May 12th-16th	GOLD to provide Kindergarten Readiness information to our staff and the state of Colorado. This information is used to determine appropriate academic supports.



DIBELS 8	READ Act Diagnostic, Interim	K-3	September 3rd-13th January 27th-31st May 12th-16th *quarterly for students on READ plans	Emails sent in August, December, and April
NWEA MAP	Interim, Summative	K-3 (Math)	September 23rd-27th January 21st-24th May 5th-9th	NWEA Map is used as a local assessment to gather baseline and diagnostic data on our students to support data driven decision making. This data is used when creating and evaluating our Unified Improvement Plan and creating academic interventions for our students.
COGAT		2nd Grade	March 13th	CoGat is used as a screener for our Gifted and Talented Program. All schools in the state of Colorado must screen all students to support in the determination of qualifying for GT programs. AAK screens all 2nd grade students and students who are new
